Object Handling

Using the Warner Textile Archive's unique textile collection, pupils will view works by famous artists including William Morris, Alec Hunter and Howard Hodgkin.

They will then discuss the techniques used by these artists to create new and original work.



Guided Gallery Visit

Staff will be on hand to assist during a visit around our Gallery. Using the collection as inspiration, pupils will be asked to sketch their own fabric design.



Polystyrene Printing

In the afternoon session, pupils will get the opportunity to design and create their own polystyrene printing block before producing their own artwork.
